- Multiple primaries calculator
- Printable and exportable code lists
 - ICD-O-3
 - ICD-9-CM
 - ICD-10

- Stand-alone application
- Download from SEER website
- Data in non-standard format

What's Next?



- Complete
 - Standardized, portable, maintainable format (XML)

Hematopoietic Database

What's Next?



- In progress
 - DLL to enable other applications to run heme db
 - APIs to enable applications to call functions that perform all of the functionality

- Heme database integrated within
 - SEER*Abs (in current version)
 - SEER*DMS (Version 10, August 2011)
