5. Guest Talk: Overview of VPR and current progress Castine Clerkin Not all members were familiar with the VPR. Castine provided high-level background on intent of the VPR, results and processes of recent pilot cohorts, as well as the VPR work on compiling and streamlining national-level IRB for studies involving patient identifies for linkage. Members had questions about why some states were unable to participate. Castine described the VPR tracking system as well as the national-level de-duplication project and the hashing approach.
